**ITEM NO. 2: APPRAISAL CASES FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE:**

**2.1 Expansion of Bahra University, Village Wakna & Bisha, Tehsil Kandaghat, District Solan, H.P by M/s Bahra Educational & Charitable Trust.**

The Project Proponent gave a detailed presentation on the proposed Project before the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC). The project proponent admitted that the total built up area at present is more than 20,000 square metres. SEAC would not consider unless information on following is submitted:-

1. Entire project proposal for which permission under Section 118 was taken from Government for establishment of University.
2. Entire project proposal now proposed for all phases of project including the details areas constructed so far.
3. Details of construction already done along with photographs and videography of construction done till date will be submitted within a week.
4. Affidavit that no further construction will be done now onwards without Environmental Clearance.


**ITEM NO. 3: Cases for fixing of Terms of References for EIA/ EMP studies.**
